SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

It was the last workday of the week for this team of officers. One officer spent the shift at a local hospital after an arrestee had to be admitted for medical care. Despite being short-staffed, the rest of the team handled a busy day filled with constant in-progress calls for service. The most notable call involved a theft at a local retail store, where suspects stole approximately \$2,000 worth of merchandise. During the investigation, officers learned the same suspects were at another store in Modesto attempting a similar crime. Modesto PD responded and detained the individuals as they tried to steal again. All four were positively identified as the suspects from our earlier case and were arrested on felony theft charges. By the end of the shift, officers had taken 11 reports and booked five individuals into County Jail.
